

Ambulance Checklist

Sr. No.	Objective Element	Requirements	Yes	No
1	COP 2a	Is vehicle registered as an ambulance.		
2	COP 2a	Are necessary legal documents available and are within validity period. This includes vehicle registration, driver's license, PUC, Vehicle Insurance and vehicle fitness.		
3	COP 2a	Is vehicle complying with 'Minimum standards and guidelines for ambulances, National Ambulance code issued by Ministry of Road and transport and Highways.		
4	COP 2a	Is identified parking area near to emergency department used for parking ambulance.		
5	COP 2a	Is ALS ambulance equipped with necessary resources such as transport ventilator, portable suction apparatus, portable oxygen equipment, ambu resuscitation kit (for adult and pediatric), multi-para monitors, intubation equipment, AED, syringe pumps, IV lines, immobilization devices, emergency medicines etc.		
6	COP 2a	Is BLS ambulance equipped with basic things like stretchers, emergency medicines, portable oxygen, suction devices and first aid kit.		
7	COP 2a	Is the staff in ambulance (driver and technician) trained in BLS skills.		
8	COP 2a	Is ambulance checked daily for things like lights, siren, tyre pressure, fuel etc., the checklist is recorded.		
9	COP2 a	Is all equipment as per list in ambulance maintained and equipment checked daily to ensure its functionality, the checklist is recorded.		
10	COP2 a	Is all medicines as per list maintained in each ambulance and the medicines checked for its quantity daily and before every dispatch of ambulance, the checklist is documented.		
11	COP 2a	Does staff in ambulance have devices (mobile phone, etc.) to communicate with hospital.		
12	COP 2 a	Is staff in ambulance aware of basic emergency management skills like immobilization technique, safe transfer of patient, use of oxygen, medication administration etc.
