

Assessment criteria and Fee structure

NOTE:

The man days given above for assessment are indicative and may change depending on the facilities and size of the hospital.

Service Tax as applicable will be charged on all the above fees. You are requested to please include the service tax in the fees accordingly.

GUIDANCE NOTES:

1. All payments to be made online. Fee is non-refundable.
2. The certification fee does not include expenses on travel, lodging/ boarding of assessors, which will be borne by the Healthcare Organisation (HCO) on actual basis.
3. The certification, once granted will be valid for two years. The HCO may apply for renewal as per the NABH policy.
4. NABH may call for an un-announced visit, which could be a Surprise Assessment or based on any concern or any serious incident reported upon by any individual or organisation or media

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Advance Stroke Centre

- NABH accredited and/or certified HCO and SHCO
- Availability of a structured system for Stroke care
- All statutory requirements are fulfilled
- Centre is functional since last 6 months.
- The implementation of standards in its organization for a minimum of three months
- Serve a minimum of 120 patients / year (or 10 per month) of Stroke
- A minimum of 10 patients/month
- 6 endovascular thrombectomies and 12 thrombolysis a year
- Acute stroke team available 24/7 along with Neurologist available 24/7
- Neuro-interventionist
- Designated beds along with neuro-intensive care unit for complex stroke patients

- In-house diagnostic services available 24/7: - ECG - EEG - CT scan and CT Angiography - MRI and MR Angiography - Transthoracic echocardiography - RBS, CBC, INR, Serum Creatinine
- Cath lab (single or biplane) 24x7 is mandatory
- Carotid duplex ultrasound
- CT Perfusion/ MR Perfusion
- Ability to provide IV thrombolytic
- Designated Certification Coordinator for Stroke Centre Certification.
- Designated Nurse Stroke Coordinator
- Written protocol for triage, diagnosis & emergency stroke treatment
- Telemedicine agreement/ policy and procedure
- Evaluation, monitoring & reporting of Key Indicators
