REVISION OF FEE STRUCTURE FOR HOSPITAL AND SHCO ACCREDITATION PROGRAMS w.e.f. 1st APRIL, 2024

Dear Partner Hospitals,

It is to inform all the accredited and applicant hospitals that NABH has decided to rationalize the fee structure for its Accreditation programs for HCOs and SHCOs.

You must be aware that NABH has not revised the Application & Annual Accreditation fee since year 2017. This is despite inflation and significant increase in operational costs. Presently, NABH is in the process of bringing reforms in the accreditation process through upgrading of portals for Accreditation and Certification programs for Hospitals and SHCOs, using technology for assisting hospitals, increasing manpower at NABH Secretariat with the intent to improve quality of assessments and improving TAT of applications.

After careful consideration and in response to evolving circumstances, NABH has decided to raise the Annual Accreditation fees of Hospital and SHCO Accreditation programs which will be effective from **1st April 2024**. However, the application fees for all the categories shall remain the same.

The detailed revision of fee structure for HCO and SHCO program is as under:

We thank you for your continued support and commitment towards quality and appreciate your understanding & cooperation as we work to maintain the excellence of our accreditation programs.

Note 1:

For accredited HCOs and SHCOs: The hospitals and SHCOs for which the date of payment of their respective annual accreditation fee falls on or after 1st April, 2024, the revised fees shall be applicable. e.g., the revised fee structure shall be applicable to the hospitals and SHCOs accredited on or after 1st April of the previous years.

For new applicant HCOs and SHCOs: The revised fee structure shall be applicable to the applicant hospitals and SHCOs. The date of grant of accreditation will be considered for the payment of annual accreditation fee e.g for the hospital which has applied for accreditation before 01.04.2024 but granted accreditation on or after 01.04.2024 shall pay annual accreditation fee as per revised/new fee structure.

Note 2: Fee once paid is non-refundable and non-transferable.
